

### **About the Project**

- Milling and resurfacing of existing McGregor Boulevard roadway from Manuels Drive to Cleveland Avenue (US 41)
  - Replace and maintain some water line and storm drainage
  - Replace existing concrete sidewalk and curb (where disturbed)
  - Upgrade street signs
  - Provide pedestrian crossing improvements
- Project completion expected in summer 2023

2. Llewellyn Drive will be modified to a one lane dedicated ingress on the south side and one lane dedicated egress on the north side of the Rachel at the Well fountain.

3. Solar-powered Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) proposed at Clifford Street





4. Solar powered digital radar speed signs and flashing signal ahead signs to be installed in the vicinity of the Edison and Ford Winter Estates crosswalk.

## What to Expect During Construction

- The City's goal is to maintain two-way traffic on McGregor Boulevard when possible.
  - Most work will occur where two lanes of traffic and a center turn lane is present.
  - Periodic delays are expected.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours.
- Motorists should plan for extra travel time or seek alternate routes during the project.



## What to Expect During Construction

- Access will be maintained
  - Location of work may shift daily
  - You may need to alter your usual route
  - You may need to move your vehicle





### Progression of Work

- Crews will begin by installing Royal Palm tree protection devices, erosion control and maintenance of traffic signs.
- The contractor is expected to work in multiple areas at the same time.
- Final paving is expected in summer 2023.





#### **Emergency and Public Services**

• EMS, FMPD, FM Fire, and LCSO notified of construction and changes to traffic plan during construction.

- Public services
  - USPS mail & business deliveries
  - Garbage/recycle pick-up
  - Lawn and household services
  - Lee County School, LeeTran and paratransit services
- Special medical or other transportation services.

# Water Shut Off/Boil Water Notices

- Planned water shut offs will occur to connect some residents and businesses to the new main.
  - Notifications of water shut off/boil water
  - Boil/use bottled water until rescission notice
  - Typically lasts 3-5 days
- Emergency water line breaks may occur.
  - Keep extra bottled water on hand in case of an emergency water line break.


